

Exciting Changes Ahead for CEIF

Over the past couple years, the leadership of CEIF has been in focused prayer, seeking God's direction for this ministry as to how best use its' mission to serve His Kingdom. We have tried to be patient and wait for His clear instructions. Recently, we received the answers to those prayers in the form of a couple changes we are confident will help us better serve you. Perhaps, like most things in life, it might take a bit of time to allow for these adjustments. However, we are hopeful that God's faithfulness will allow us to look back on these changes as positive improvements.

First, we are excited to announce the opening of a **second CEIF office**. As of **June 30, 2014** we will have an office open in Elk Grove, California. Our largest group of churches and investors are located in the West and we believe we can best serve this region by having an office in the area. We also know that a vital part of our ministry is located in the Midwest and East, so we will continue to maintain an office in Illinois so that we can best serve these regions as well.

Now, you might be asking yourself, "How do I know what number to call if I need to get in touch with you?" The good news is that the phone numbers will remain the same. If you call our **800 number, both offices will ring**. To you, it will be seamless. Previously, our constituents on the West coast would need to call us before 2:00 pm because our office in Illinois would be closing. However, **after June 1st, 2014**, when you call CEIF, we will have someone ready to serve you **8:00 am to 6:30 pm (CST)**.

If you need to mail a correspondence to us, you can **begin sending correspondence to the Elk Grove office at 9401 E. Stockton Boulevard, Suite 240, Elk Grove, CA, 95624** effective **June 30, 2014**. However, if you forget and mistakenly send it to the Glen Ellyn office, don't worry. We'll take care of it for you.

The second change we are excited to announce is a **name change**. It's not much of a change, but we feel it is one that will make it easier to communicate who we are. Over the years we have been known as Church Extension Investors Fund (CEIF), but it has always been a mouthful for anyone to say and has actually caused confusion to many. Therefore, we are dropping the word "Extension". We will now be doing business as "**Church Investors Fund**" (CIF). Much simpler, right?

If you are wondering about our email addresses and website - don't worry. We have **kept our email addresses** exactly as they are (____@ceif.org). If you want to visit our website you can still visit us at www.ceif.org, but you can now also visit us at www.cifinc.org, www.churchinvestorsfund.org or www.churchinvestorsfund.com. Each of these website addresses will take you where you want to go.

Lastly, if you still refer to us as CEIF, don't worry; we will still respond and accept any correspondence as such. We are not completely abandoning the CEIF name. We know who we are and where we came from. We are merely simplifying it so that current and future ministry partners can understand more of the ministry itself and place less focus on what the acronym CEIF stands for. So say it with me: "**Church Investors Fund**" or "**CIF**". It rolls off the tongue better, doesn't it?

RECIPE CORNER

INGREDIENTS: LEMON GLAZE

- 3 c powdered sugar
- 1/4 c Real Lemon Juice (Brand)
- 3 Tbs melted butter
- 3 Tbs boiling water

INGREDIENTS: CAKE

- 1 pkg. lemon velvet cake mix (Betty Crocker)
- 1 pkg. lemon instant pudding
- 4 eggs
- 3/4 c water
- 3/4 c salad oil

LEMON GLAZE CAKE

FROM THE KITCHEN OF: NANCY KLEISS, GLADWIN, MI

DIRECTIONS:

Beat together all cake ingredients for 4 minutes. Pour into two greased loaf pans or one 9"x13" pan. Bake 40-50 minutes at 350°F.

Mix together all lemon glaze ingredients. When cake is done, poke holes from top to bottom of cake (about 60). Allow to cool 5 minutes, then pour lemon glaze over top, letting it fill all the holes on the cake. ENJOY! ❁
